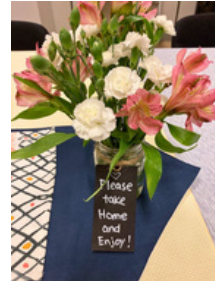

### Belgo Learning Priority

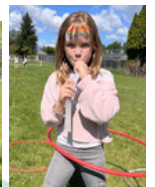
- Students will deepen their numeracy skills by sharing their thinking and engaging in real-world, task-based problem solving, using a variety of strategies. (Year 2)


